He worked at Brooklyn Motors/Inner Harbor Ford for more than 23 years as their body tech and frame man. As a hobby, for a number of years he worked on race cars.

His every day cars at some point in his life included a 39 Ford Sedan, 57 Chevy, 64 Pontiac and a 71 Pontiac.

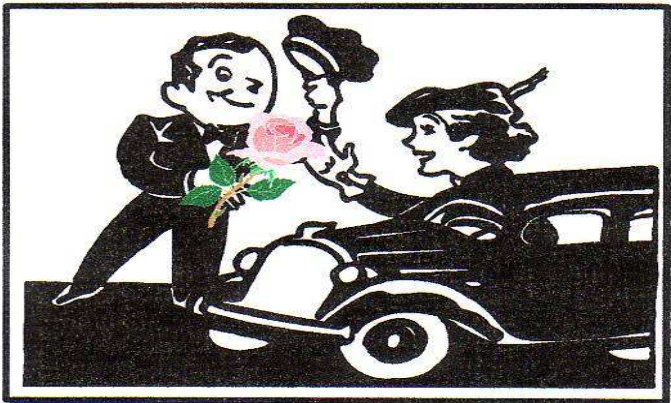

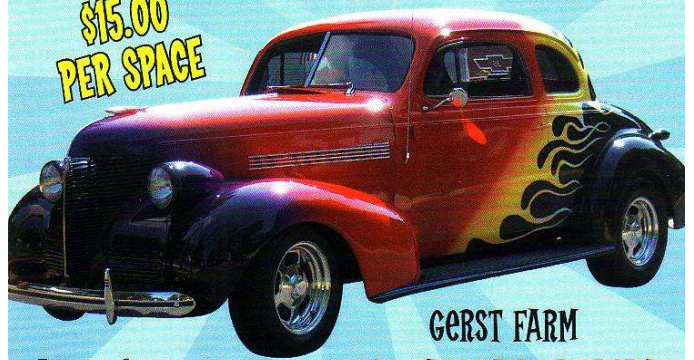


