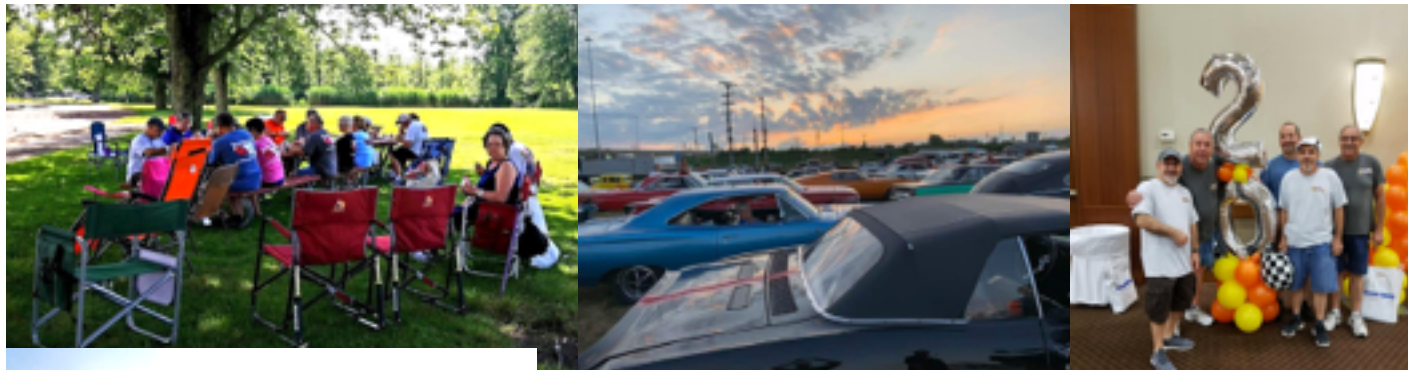

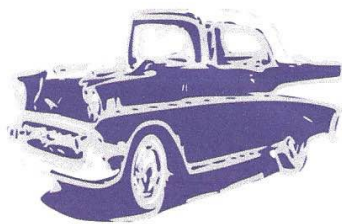
Registration: This year's registration fee will be \$10.00 (\$11 if purchased online) per antique auto. This fee will cover any day or days you wish to attend the festival. Your registration includes free admission for 2 people in the car. If there are more than two people in your auto, the additional people will be charged \$5.00 per person at the gate. Please do not bring cars newer than 1980 and cars must be in show quality condition. Due to limited space, we can only accept 250 cars per festival day. All autos attending the display must be pre-registered. Registrations are accepted on a first come first serve basis. All registrations must be received by September 1st due to mailing confirmation letters. Display cars must be present on the festival grounds by 11:00 a.m. daily or they will not be admitted. Please plan for the festival traffic so you arrive at the festival by 11:00 a.m. (Worship services are held in Apple Auditorium at 10:00 a.m. each Sunday). No tents or canopies permitted in display area. Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.

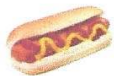

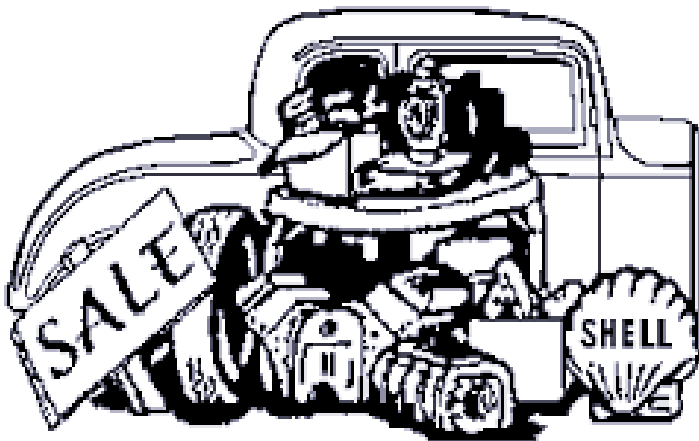

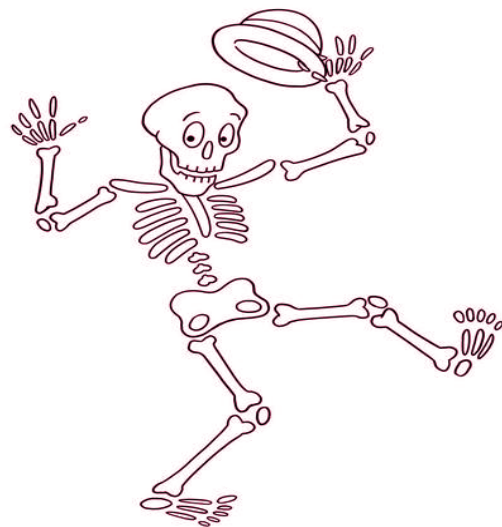
