She also spoke to Beef-a-lo Bobs about the deposit we paid for our Anniversary Dinner. They said we can use it to purchase food, possibly for the picnic or it can be used for gift cards. They will work with us. The deposit cannot be refunded.

Tom presented Mary Cox with a plaque for her 12 years as Treasurer. The Club voted in agreement on the addendum to the By Laws to make the Club dues \$25.00 all year. Jen and Mike attended the Sue Island Car Show and won a trophy.

The location of the next meeting will be decided as soon as we check with the Elks to see if they will allow us there. The next meeting is scheduled for July 15th and needs to be confirmed. Members will be notified.
