Tickets to the Dance are still available and can be purchased by calling Janet Woolridge 410-247-4643.

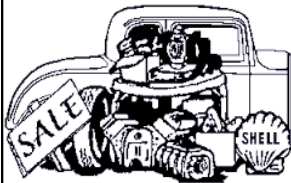

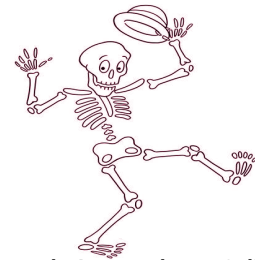

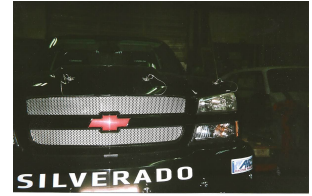
